

TSA Calendar History

- The numbers within the colored bars denote the number of days within that time period
- The **Preseason** refers to the days between the last day of school and the first day of the dual meet season, not inclusive
- The **Season** starts on the day of the first scheduled dual meet and ends on the day of the final scheduled dual meet
- The **Postseason** refers to the days between the final dual meet and the first day of school, not inclusive
- The school dates shown are from the Wake County Public School System's traditional (not year-round) calendar
- School Make-up days, where known (1991 and later), refer to days added to the school calendar to make up for days missed for inclement weather
- For years prior to 1991, only the actual last day of school is shown; it is unknown whether any of those days were make-up days
- Starting in summer 2005, a new state law mandated that traditional-calendar school years must begin no earlier than August 25 and end no later than June 10
- The 1999 TSA season included an extra week which all teams took as a bye, apparently due to the presence of the Special Olympics in the Triangle that summer
- The 1984 TSA season was the final one in which some teams swam 7 dual meets, and the final one with a school summer break that lasted through Labor Day
